Covid19-related advocacy work

Meeting with Health Minister Harris confirmed

We received confirmation that we will have a virtual meeting with the Minister of Health. Since the onset of the pandemic, we have sent numerous letters to Minister Harris outlining the need for a human rights-based approach to guide all decisions taken regarding the introduction and review of Regulations.

Call for an end to extraordinary policing powers in phase 2

We believe that the current policing powers of enforcement are now inappropriate and unworkable. We <u>have called for their cessation</u>. The call comes as the Government must decide if it is necessary to extend the Regulations providing for additional garda powers and the criminalisation of movement beyond 8 June.

We emphasise our continued strong support for the public health advice and government efforts to curb the spread of COVID19 but insist that **public health advice should not be enforced by criminal law, but rather by consent and cooperation.**

Published: our principled framework for the contact-tracing & symptom-tracking app

We, together with other civil societies, scientists and academics, wrote to the Minister of Health and to the special Oireachtas Covid-19 response Committee setting out <u>9 Principles</u> for the Government. This Principles should be adhered to by the Government to ensure they fulfil their legal human rights obligations towards the development of a privacy-protecting app. Press Release can be found <u>here</u>.

Letter to the Oireachtas covid-19 response Committee on travel restrictions

We wrote to the Oireachtas covid-19 response Committee ahead of their travel restrictions session this week. We highlighted our concerns regarding the Regulations which came into effect on 29 May, criminalising incoming passengers' refusal to complete the passenger locator form. We also drew the Committee's attention to our 20 May letter to the Health Minister.
